The first monks: before 600 BC Hinduism, the earliest among the world's great religions, is also probably the first to involve a form of monasticism. The rejection of worldly goods and desires, central to the Hindu concept of holiness, inclines devotees to conditions of poverty - among them the life of a hermit.

A matha (, IAST: ma ha), also written as math, matha or mutt, is a Sanskrit word that means "institute or college", and it also refers to a monastery in Hinduism.. Monastic life, for spiritual studies or the pursuit of moksha (spiritual liberation) traces its roots to the 1st millennium BCE, in the Vedic tradition. The earliest Hindu monasteries (mathas)

Sannyasa — the act of renouncing material life to pursue a spiritual life.
