In 1913 10% of the world's population lived in cities (UN-HABITAT, 2011), in 2018 this had increased to an estimated 55% ().Urban areas are expected to absorb virtually all future population growth and by 2030 are projected to accommodate 60% of the global population: one-third of which will live in cities with at least half a million inhabitants ().
